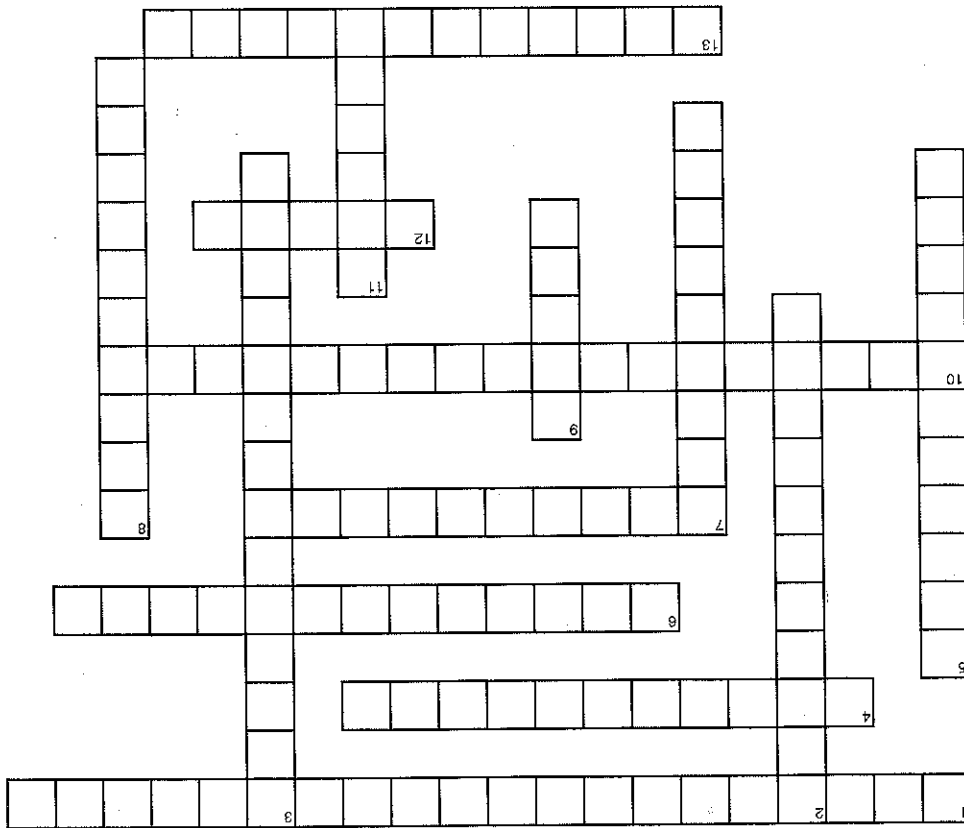


EARTHQUAKE VOCABULARY CROSSWORD

DOWN

- 1 (3 WRDS) ROCKS CAN BE COMPRESSED/STRETCHED UP TO A LIMIT, THEN BREAK
- 4 YOU NEED THREE SEISMOGRAPH STATIONS TO LOCATE THE EPICENTER OF AN EARTHQUAKE
- 6 (2 WRDS) MEASURES THE INTENSITY OF AN EARTHQUAKE
- 7 SHAKING OF THE EARTH CAUSED BY SUDDEN MOVEMENTS OF ROCK BENEATH THE EARTH SURFACE
- 10 THE DRIVING FORCE OF PLATE TECTONICS IN WHICH HOT MATERIAL FROM THE MANTLE RISES TO THE LITHOSPHERE
- 12 COMBINATION OF BACK AND FORTH AND UP AND DOWN MOTION. ONLY TRAVEL ON SURFACE
- 13 (2 WRDS) MEASURES THE ENERGY RELEASED OR MAGNITUDE OF AN EARTHQUAKE
- 2 (2 WRDS) ONLY TRAVEL THROUGH THE EARTH'S CRUST
- 3 (2 WRDS) ALSO KNOWN AS SECONDARY WAVE
- 5 (2 WRDS) VIBRATIONS CAUSED BY MOVEMENT OF THE PLATES AT A TFB POINT ON THE EARTH'S SURFACE
- 7 POINT ON THE EARTH'S SURFACE DIRECTLY ABOVE THE FOCUS
- 8 THE STUDY OF EARTHQUAKES
- 9 EXACT POINT WHERE ROCK FIRST BREAKS AND ENERGY IS RELEASED
- 11 FASTEST SEISMIC WAVES THAT ARE THE FIRST TO REACH RECORDING STATION
